ENGLISH REVIEW--Grades 9-10, Block B

The course will consist of varying degrees of composition, grammar and literature depending on individual and class needs.

ENGLISH REVIEW--Grades 11-12, Block A

GEOMETRY REVIEW--Grades 8-12, Block A

TUITION: Resident: \$265.00 Non-Resident: \$295.00

Provides an opportunity for students to make up failing grades in Geometry. All students will be tested during the first few days of the course to see where they need assistance and further instruction.

ALGEBRA REVIEW--Grades 8-12, Block B

Provides an opportunity for students to make up failing grades in Algebra. All students will be tested during the first few days of the course to see where they need assistance and further instruction.. Lyme-Old Lyme High School students must take and pass department final exam for credit.

U.S. HISTORY REVIEW--Grades 9-12, Block A

CIVICS--Grades 10-12, Block B

This course will review the concepts of the United States government and related documents designed for the student who needs to make-up class for loss of credit. *The students taking this as an enrichment course, receiving the full half-credit required by the State of CT, will be required to complete outside the scope of the class sessions, additional research and reflection.

SCIENCE REVIEW--Grades 8-12, Block A

This non-lab course will concentrate on the foundation concepts of courses like Earth Science, Physical Science, Biology or Chemistry. The individual and small group sessions will enable students to tailor their review experience.

***MARINE BIOLOGY--Grades 8-12, Block B**

FORENSIC SCIENCE --Block A

***Enrichment Credit Resident: \$300.00 Non-Resident: \$325.00**

Forensic Science is a lab-based enrichment course that focuses on the analysis of physical evidence found at crime scenes. Some of the topics we will investigate could include: analysis of a crime scene, Fingerprint analysis, Hair and fiber analysis, Blood (typing and spatter patterns) and Document and handwriting analysis.
